

**A RESOLUTION CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND  
DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE NOVEMBER 5, 2019,  
CITY SPECIAL ELECTION REGARDING AMENDMENTS  
TO THE CITY CHARTER**

**WHEREAS**, the City held a Special Election on November 5, 2019, for the purpose of submitting to the eligible voters of the City, 18 propositions (A-R) regarding amendments to the City Charter; and

**WHEREAS**, it is found that the Special Election was held in accordance with the authorized procedures; that notice of the Special Election was duly given in the form, manner, and time required by law; and that the Special Election was in all respects legally held and conducted in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary for the City Council to canvass the returns of the Special Election and to declare the results thereof;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF KERRVILLE, KERR COUNTY, TEXAS:**

**SECTION ONE.** The statements and findings provided above are adopted.

**SECTION TWO.** The official tally, presented by the election judge as shown in **Exhibit A**, is approved and accepted.

**SECTION THREE.** From the returns duly and legally made, there were 2,870 valid and legal voters; and that the propositions in the Special Election received the following votes:


