In an effort to avoid and mitigate health risks, standard safety protocols must be observed by board members, City staff, and citizens/visitors attending this meeting. Anyone attending this meeting must wear a mask into the Library, sanitize their hands, and have their temperature taken prior to entering the meeting. Anyone with a temperature greater than 100.1 will not be allowed entry. All attendees must wear a mask at all times. The City will observe six-foot distance seating and will designate allowable seating. The public podium will be sanitized between each speaker. Note that no online (virtual) meeting is offered for this meeting.
