Library to begin homebound delivery

Kerrville, Texas (Jan. 28, 2021)—The Butt-Holdsworth Memorial Library is excited to offer homebound delivery services to eligible patrons beginning Feb. 1. To be eligible, the patron must meet the following qualifications:

- 1.** Confined to their home due to prolonged illness, extended convalescences or advanced age and have no household member available to go to the library for items;



- 2.** Have a temporary or permanent physical or mental disability that prevents them from coming to the library.

The library may request verification of homebound status. Acceptable verifying entities may include a doctor, social worker or case manager. Applicants are required to have a library

card in good standing. Staff is available to assist those who need to apply for a library card and/or homebound service.
