

**CITY OF KERRVILLE, TEXAS
RESOLUTION NO. 45-2021**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR THE HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT PROGRAM (HMPG) DR-4586 TO THE TEXAS DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO ACT AS THE CITY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICERS AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVES IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THIS PROGRAM

WHEREAS, City Council desires to develop a viable community and preserve the health and public safety of its residents; and

WHEREAS, certain conditions exist which at times represent a threat to public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interests of the City to apply for funding under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMPG) DR-4586 (the "Program") as a way to mitigate these hazards; and

WHEREAS, an award of Program funds will require a local funding match from the City and the City would be responsible for all non-reimbursable costs and 100% of overruns, if any;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KERRVILLE, KERR COUNTY, TEXAS:


SECTION ONE. The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to submit an application for the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMPG) with the Texas Division of Emergency Management, and that such application be placed in competition for funding under the HMPG DR-4586.

SECTION TWO. City Council directs and designates the Mayor and City Manager as the City's Chief Executive Officers and Authorized Representatives to act in all matters in connection with this application and the City's participation in the HMPG DR-4586.

SECTION THREE. The City agrees and will take steps to ensure that all funds will be used in accordance with all applicable federal, state, local, and HMPG requirements including procurement, environmental review, labor standards, real property acquisition, and civil rights requirements. In addition, the City is required to provide a local funding match and is thereafter responsible for all non-reimbursable costs and 100% of overruns, if any.
