### **Enjoy Spring Break at Kerrville-Schreiner Park**

**Kerrville, Texas (March 4, 2022)** – Looking for spring break plans? Stay and play at Kerrville-Schreiner Park! The Kerrville Parks and Recreation Department encourages our community and visitors to check out Kerrville-Schreiner Park all year and especially during Spring Break too. The park is located at 2385 Bandera Hwy. and rests along the Guadalupe River with a variety of fun camping options such as RV sites with amenities ranging from water and electric to 30 and 50-amp full RV hookup sites, tent camping, cabins, group rental facilities, and even a rental house.



Facilities at Kerrville-Schreiner Park include a recreation hall, dining hall, and day-use areas including playground, pollinator garden, sand volleyball, basketball, 10+ miles of hike and bike trails, river trail access, Guadalupe River access, kayak and canoe rentals, fishing, swimming, and picnic areas with standing grills throughout. Make your overnight reservation now as spots are filling up fast.

Day-use admission fees are \$6 for ages 13 years +, \$2 for children and seniors (65 years+), and are FREE for veterans and active duty military (proof of service required). Better yet, purchase an annual pass! Annual passes are only \$50 per year with a 50 percent discount when purchasing a second pass. Purchase an annual pass anytime during March 11-20 and receive a free Kerrville-Schreiner Park give-a-way.

- **"Campfire Night"** – On Saturday, March 19 at 6:30 p.m., we will be hosting a "Campfire Night" prior to the start of "Movies in the Park". S'more supplies will be available,

while supplies last. Enjoy roasting marshmallows over the fire and spending quality time with family and friends in the great outdoors!

- **“Movies in the Park”** – Also on Saturday, March 19, the “Movies in the Park” series is back with “Raya and the Last Dragon” (PG) at the Kerrville-Schreiner Park amphitheater. The movie will begin at 7:45 p.m. or dark. Bring the family, chairs, blankets, insect repellent, and a flashlight for an outdoor evening of fun. Free popcorn will be served and drinks will be available for purchase.
