History Center to host “Top 40 Birds of the Hill Country” Saturday

Kerrville, Texas (April 5, 2022) – The Kerr Regional History Center is pleased to announce an afternoon with Paul and Deloris Sellin presenting the “Top 40 Birds of the Hill Country: Nesting Birds” on Saturday, April 9 from 2 – 3 p.m.

Native Texan Deloris Sellin and 44-year Texan Paul Sellin have been birdwatching in Texas and nationally since 1995. Since moving to Kerr County



in 2015, Deloris, a retired school librarian and educator, and Paul, a retired Texas CPA and auditor, have continued their interest in sharing their knowledge of birds, especially by leading the Riverside Nature Center’s monthly birdwalk since the spring of 2016. They have participated each year in two or more Christmas bird counts in Kerr and Bandera counties.

Both Paul and Deloris have photographed and recorded hundreds of species of birds in Texas. Using stats from a worldwide-used birding application, eBird, Paul is ranked No. 1 in species seen or heard in Kerr County and is No. 17 for species seen or heard in Texas.

The public is encouraged to attend this free event and learn about the birds of the Hill Country. The Kerr Regional History Center is located at 425 Water Street on the Butt-Holdsworth Memorial Library campus.
