Kerrville Parks and Recreation Department facilities draw UIL regional tennis and golf tournaments

Kerrville, Texas (April 14, 2022) – On April 11-12, the Kerrville Tennis Complex, 801 Tennis St., was the host site for this year's Class 3A Region IV University Interscholastic League district tennis tournament. This tournament consisted of 175 players from 24 schools and more than



300 spectators. Participating schools came from near and far to compete and utilize the newly renovated tennis complex. The participating schools included Ingram, Blanco, Lago Vista, Stockdale, Randolph, Marion, Jourdanton, Poteet, Dilley, Goliad,

Corpus Christi London, Columbus, Hallettsville, Mathis, Lytle, Karnes City, Industrial, Bishop, Weslaco, Hebronville, Orange Grove, Poth, Edna and Palacios.

“The purpose of the recent renovation was to enhance the facility, which would subsequently increase tournament play, encourage tourism, enhance traffic to local

businesses, and provide a quality of life amenity for local residents,” Director of Parks and Recreation Ashlea Boyle said. “It is great to see this vision continuing to be successful. We are fortunate to have excellent facilities and professionals that provide valuable services to our community and visitors”.

The Kerrville Tennis Complex will also be hosting the Division 3 Southern Collegiate Athletic Conference Championship Tennis Tournament later this month.



In addition, the Scott Schreiner Golf Course, 1 Country Club Dr., will be the host site for the Region IV-3A UIL district golf tournament beginning April 18-20. This tournament will bring 180 players and spectators to Kerrville for friendly competition. The 18-hole course is great for tournaments and daily play. Participating schools include Lago Vista, Marion, London, Llano, Columbus, Santa Gertrudis, Randolph, Jourdanton, Poth, Santa Rosa, Odem, Weslaco, Brownsville, Orange Grove, Lyford, Hallettsville, Goliad, Mathis, San Diego, Monte Vista, Edna, Luling, West Campus, Karnes City, Poteet, Stockdale, Progresso, Aransas Pass, Industrial, Dilley and Blanco.

“We are eager to see kids and their supporters come out and enjoy the game of golf,” said Bobby Morriss, golf pro shop manager.
