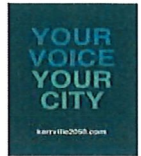

WHEREAS, the City of Kerrville, Texas, held its general election on the 1st Saturday of May 2022 (May 7, 2022), for the purpose of electing a Mayor, Councilmember Place Three, and Councilmember Place Four, each to serve a two-year term; and

WHEREAS, it is found and determined that said election was held in accordance with the authorized procedures; that notice of the election was duly given in the form, manner, and time required by law; and that said election was in all respects legally held and conducted in accordance with the applicable laws of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and legally required for the City Council to canvass the returns of this election and to declare the official results;

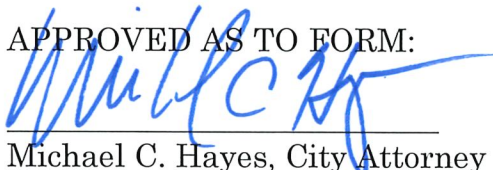

CONNECTION THEREWITH**

WHEREAS, City Council ordered an election to be held on May 7, 2022 for the purpose of determining whether the qualified voters of the City would authorize the issuance of general obligation bonds by the City; and

WHEREAS, Council has reviewed and investigated all matters pertaining to this election, including the resolution, notices, election officers, holding, and returns thereof; and

WHEREAS, Council has diligently inquired into the poll lists and the official election returns which were duly and lawfully made to the Council by the judges and clerks holding and conducting such election; the poll lists and the official election returns showing separately the votes cast in the election; and

WHEREAS, from these returns, Council hereby finds that the following votes were cast in the election by voters who were qualified voters of the City:

PROPOSITION A

**THE ISSUANCE OF CITY OF KERRVILLE, TEXAS, GENERAL
OBLIGATION BONDS FOR A PUBLIC SAFETY FACILITY AND
THE LEVYING OF A TAX IN PAYMENT THEREOF, IN AN
AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$45,000,000.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF KERRVILLE, TEXAS THAT:**

SECTION ONE. Council officially finds, determines, and declares that the election was properly ordered, that legal notice of such election was properly given,

that proper election officers were appointed prior to the election, that the election was legally held, that all qualified voters of the City were permitted to vote at the election, that due returns of the results of the election had been made and delivered, and that the Council has duly canvassed such returns, all in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and of the United States of America, and the order calling the election.

SECTION TWO. A MAJORITY of the qualified voters of the City of Kerrville, Texas voting in such election, having voted FOR Proposition A, Council hereby finds and determines this Proposition carried at the election, that the election was duly called, that proper notice was given, and that the election was held in all aspects in conformity with the law, and that Council is hereby accordingly authorized to issue the bonds and to levy the tax in accordance with the authority granted in the Proposition and with law.

SECTION THREE. The recitals contained in the preamble hereof are hereby found to be true, and such recitals are hereby made a part of this Resolution for all purposes and are adopted as a part of the judgment and findings of Council.

SECTION FOUR. All ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, which are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provisions of this Resolution shall be and remain controlling as to the matters resolved herein.

SECTION FIVE. This Resolution shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and the United States of America.

SECTION SIX. If any provision of this Resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall be held to be invalid, the remainder of this Resolution and the application of such provision to other persons and circumstances shall nevertheless be valid, and Council hereby declares that this Resolution would have been enacted without such invalid provision.

SECTION SEVEN. It is officially found, determined, and declared that the meeting at which this Resolution is adopted was open to the public and public notice of the time, place, and subject matter of the public business to be considered at such meeting, including this Resolution, was given, all as required by Chapter 551, as amended, Texas Government Code.

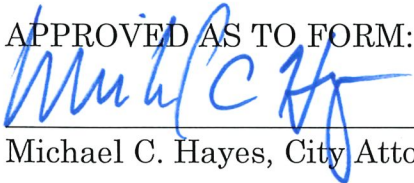

AHORA, POR LO TANTO, SERÁ RESUELTO POR EL CONCEJO MUNICIPAL DE LA CIUDAD DE KERRVILLE, TEXAS QUE:

SECCIÓN PRIMERA. El Concejo oficialmente encuentra, determina y declara que la elección fue ordenada correctamente, que el aviso legal de dicha elección fue debidamente dado, que los oficiales electorales adecuados fueron nombrados antes de la elección, que la elección se llevó a cabo legalmente, que todos los votantes calificados de la Ciudad pudieron votar en la elección, que se habían hecho y entregado los debidos resultados de la elección, y que el Consejo ha sondeado debidamente esas declaraciones, todo ello de conformidad con las leyes del Estado de Texas y de los Estados Unidos de América, y la orden de convocatoria de las elecciones.

SECCIÓN SEGUNDA. Una MAYORÍA de los votantes calificados de la Ciudad de Kerrville, Texas que votan en dicha elección, habiendo votado POR la Proposición A, el Concejo por la presente encuentra y determina esta Proposición llevada a cabo en la elección, que la elección fue debidamente convocada, que se dio la notificación adecuada y que la elección se llevó a cabo en todos los aspectos de conformidad con la ley, y que el Consejo está autorizado en consecuencia a emitir los bonos y a recaudar el impuesto de conformidad con la autoridad otorgada en la Proposición y con la ley.

SECCIÓN TERCERA. Los considerandos contenidos en el preámbulo del presente documento se consideran ciertos, y dichos considerandos se incorporan a la presente Resolución a todos los efectos y se adoptan como parte del juicio y las conclusiones del Consejo.

SECCIÓN CUARTA. Todas las ordenanzas y resoluciones, o partes de las mismas, que estén en conflicto o sean inconsistentes con cualquier disposición de esta Resolución se derogan en la medida de dicho conflicto, y las disposiciones de esta Resolución serán y seguirán siendo controladoras en cuanto a los asuntos resueltos en este documento.

SECCIÓN QUINTA. Esta Resolución se interpretará y aplicará de acuerdo con las leyes del Estado de Texas y los Estados Unidos de América.

SECCIÓN SEXTA. Si alguna disposición de esta Resolución o la aplicación de la misma a cualquier persona o circunstancia se considera inválida, el resto de esta Resolución y la aplicación de dicha disposición a otras personas y circunstancias serán válidas, y el Consejo declara por la presente que esta Resolución se habría promulgado sin dicha disposición inválida.

SECCIÓN SÉPTIMA. Se encuentra, determina y declara oficialmente que la reunión en la que se adopta esta Resolución estaba abierta al público y se dio aviso público de la hora, el lugar y el tema de los negocios públicos que se considerarán en dicha reunión, incluida esta Resolución, todo según lo requerido por el Capítulo 551, según enmendado, código de gobierno de Texas.

SECCIÓN OCTAVA. La presente Resolución estará vigente y surtirá efecto a partir de su aprobación definitiva y así se resolverá.
