entry must be submitted via e-mail to be considered valid. Submissions will be judged based on the digital format submitted only; there will not be in-person judging. By submitting an entry, participants agree for their photo/video submissions to be displayed publicly. Decorations must be appropriate for public display and Halloween-themed, but are not limited to skeletons and scarecrows.

The City of Kerrville reserves the right to refuse any entries not in compliance with the family-oriented guideline and high standards of the contest. Discretion is to be used when deciding whether the decorations become too frightening or not appropriate for children.

Categories for judging are as follows:

- 1) Overall favorite;
- 2) Spookiest;
- 3) Most creative.

Winners will be announced on Friday, Oct. 28 via various formats such as social media, websites, and press releases.
