The city's code enforcement office will place a large dumpster on city property located on the corner of Circle Avenue and Pershing Avenue from 8 a.m. until 1 p.m. During this time, citizens will be able to get rid of all unwanted trash that has been piling up on their property. Below is a list of items that will not be allowed.

Prohibited Items:

- Tires
- New or used oil – contact Walmart Auto Care Center (830-895-7949)
- Ammunition
- Yard waste (branches, limbs, grass clippings, etc.)
- Household paints, chemicals, and other hazardous items

- Batteries – contact Scrap Solutions (830-367-1775)
