### **City offices to open at noon on Thursday; trash pickup to begin at 10 a.m.**

**Kerrville, Texas (Feb. 1, 2023)** – The City of Kerrville municipal offices, the Butt-Holdsworth Memorial Library, the Parks and Recreation Department office located at Kerrville-Schreiner Park, Development Services and Municipal Court will open at noon on Thursday, Feb. 2, due to weather conditions.

Weather permitting, Republic Services will resume garbage and recycling services at 10 a.m.



Thursday on a one-day delayed basis – i.e., Thursday garbage pickup is a make up for Wednesday, and Friday garbage pickup will be make up for Thursday. Citywide recycling will be picked up on Saturday. Citizens are encouraged to wait until Thursday morning, preferably as close to 10 a.m. as possible, before putting trash out for collection to minimize trip and fall risks.

The city's landfill and transfer station will also resume normal operations at 10 a.m. Thursday.

The National Weather Service continues to include Kerrville in a Winter Storm Warning into early Thursday morning, but temperatures are expected to climb into the 40s as the day progresses. The Kerrville Police Department, Fire Department and Public Works thank all of our citizens for their efforts to avoid travel during the previous 48 hours as emergency calls have been minimal. The KPD and KFD continue to advise citizens to stay off the roads through the night and also use caution when navigating sidewalks and driveways, as the conditions will pose significant trip and fall risks.

A warming center for the homeless is open from 8 a.m. to noon Thursday at the Salvation Army, 855 Hays Street.
