City offices to remain closed Wednesday; trash pickup delayed

Kerrville, Texas (Jan. 31, 2023) – The City of Kerrville municipal offices, the Butt-Holdsworth Memorial Library, the Parks and Recreation Department office located at Kerrville-Schreiner Park, Development Services and Municipal Court will remain closed Wednesday, Feb. 1, due to weather conditions.

Due to continued hazards resulting from inclement weather, Republic Services has suspended all normal garbage and recycling services for Wednesday. Republic Services hopes to resume collections Thursday, Feb. 2 on a one-day delayed regular schedule. A decision on Thursday operations will be made Wednesday afternoon.

In addition, the city's landfill and transfer station will be closed through Wednesday. Weather permitting, normal operations should resume Thursday.

The Kerrville Police Department, Fire Department and Public Works will continue working around the clock to respond to emergencies. If you choose to drive, be prepared to sustain yourself or walk if you become stranded or have an accident and your vehicle is disabled. The KPD and KFD continue to advise citizens to stay off the roads if possible and also use caution when navigating sidewalks and driveways, as the conditions will pose significant trip and fall risks.

For safety, people are advised to not visit parks or trails due to slip and fall concerns in addition to the risk of falling tree limbs and trees. Park amenities such as restrooms, water fountains and interactive fountains are all closed.

A warming center for the homeless is open through Feb. 2 at the Salvation Army, 855 Hays Street. Hours are 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. through Feb. 1 and 8 a.m. to noon Feb. 2.
