City now accepting applications for summer aquatics staff

Kerrville, Texas (Dec. 12, 2023) – The City of Kerrville is now accepting applications for employment at the Olympic Pool for the 2024 summer season. The first step to joining the Kerrville Aquatics team is filling out an application! Potential candidates can apply online at <https://www.kerrvilletx.gov/14/Employment>. Once there, candidates should click on the “Current Employment Opportunities” tab and apply for the correct position. Starting pay rates are as follows:

- Pool Cashier - \$13 per hour
- Lifeguard - \$14 per hour
- Assistant Pool Manager - \$15 per hour
- Pool Manager - \$16 per hour

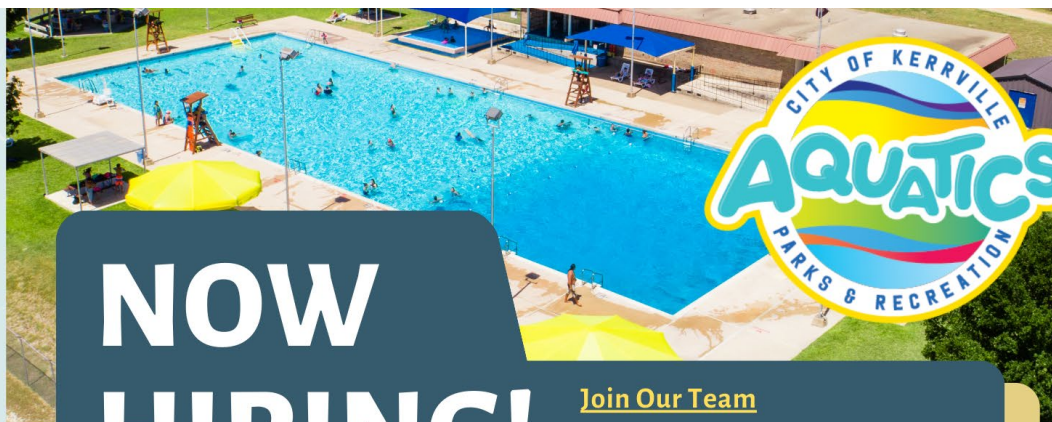


Lifeguard candidates must be at least 15 years old by May, 2024, complete a lifeguard training class, and demonstrate a professional demeanor. Ellis & Associates lifeguard training classes are provided by the Kerrville Parks and Recreation Department to candidates for a fee

and will begin in February. The city will reimburse this fee for those who complete employment through the summer and meet the eligibility criteria. Training prerequisites include a 100-yard continuous swim, treading water without using arms for one minute, and a brick retrieval from 16 feet. All candidates should be able to work a minimum of four days a week from late May through mid-August. Lifeguard experience is required for manager positions.

“Working at the Olympic Pool is a great opportunity to meet new friends, learn valuable work and life skills, and make some summer cash,” Recreation Manager Rosa Ledesma said. “All candidates are highly encouraged to apply early to not miss their opportunity to work with such an amazing team.”
