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Charter Review Commission to hold public hearing

Kerrville, Texas (Nov. 28, 2023) - The Charter Review Commission (CRC) for the City of Kerrville, Texas will hold a public hearing on Wednesday, Dec. 6, 2023, beginning at 4 p.m. at Kerrville City Hall, 701 Main St.

Prior to opening the public hearing, the CRC will make a presentation as to its proposed charter amendments. Following this presentation, the CRC will invite attendees to comment on its proposed amendments.



At the Aug. 22, 2023 City Council meeting, the Kerrville City Council authorized city staff to initiate a review of the City Charter, which is a document prepared by the citizens of Kerrville to provide direction to city government on how to operate. Section 12.06 of the

charter requires that city council initiate a charter review at least every five (5) years, such review to be conducted by a council-appointed CRC composed of seven members.

At the Sept. 12 City Council meeting, the Kerrville City Council appointed seven members to the CRC. In September, the CRC began meeting and has held five meetings since its inception. The CRC's goal is to have recommendations in the form of amendments to the charter for inclusion in a council meeting during January 2024, and for placement on the May 4, 2024 general election ballot for public consideration.

The current City Charter may be reviewed online at the city's website; or, if you prefer, the CRC will provide anyone with a copy of this document. Besides appearing before the CRC at a meeting, comments may be emailed to the CRC at stuart.cunyus@kerrvilletx.gov.

It is the CRC's hope and desire that any citizen of Kerrville with comments or questions regarding the City Charter will take the time to communicate these in some way to the CRC.
