Kerrville Sports Complex eclipse viewing location reservations opening Feb. 1

Kerrville, Texas (Feb. 1, 2024) – It's time to secure your parking spot for the April 8 total eclipse in Kerrville! The City of Kerrville Parks and Recreation Department will be selling parking passes to view the total solar eclipse at the Kerrville Sports Complex (KSC) beginning Feb. 1 at 8 a.m. A limited number of parking passes will be sold for regular-sized family vehicles to stay at the KSC to view the eclipse. Pre-purchasing a parking pass is the best way to ensure that you have a place to go on that day.

The Kerrville Sports Complex stretches across Holdsworth Dr. and consists of a baseball/softball complex, 111 Home Run Dr., and a soccer complex, 117 Sweeper Lane. Parking passes are being sold in advance only for \$75 per car (limit one per household). Parking passes will not be sold at the gate. Parking pass holders will have access to food, water, restrooms, and fields/open spaces at the KSC Viewing Location. Guests are encouraged to bring any supplies (water, food, first aid, etc.) they may need to be comfortable for the day.

Purchasing a KSC Viewing Location Parking Pass

To purchase your parking pass online follow these steps:

1. Visit our online registration site at www.kerrvilletx.gov/registration
2. Click on the "Special Events" tab and select "All Events".
3. Select the appropriate parking pass you wish to purchase and add it to your cart.

Please note: There are two sides to the Kerrville Sports Complex, make note of which side you are selecting.

4. You will then be prompted to log into your account or create one. You can create an account in advance to expedite the payment process.

5. Once you've logged in or created an account, you will be able to finalize payment.

Please ensure that your e-mail is listed correctly before processing your credit card, as the parking pass will be sent out electronically.

Parking passes will also be sold over the phone at (830) 257-7300 or in-person with the Parks Office located at 2385 Bandera Hwy.

General Rules and Policies

Below are general rules all participants should be aware of:

- Shuttle services will NOT be provided from this location to the Kerrville Eclipse Festival;

it is a park-and-stay location.

- No refunds are awarded under any conditions. ALL purchases are final and non-transferable.

- Gates will open at 8 a.m. on April 8. A hard copy proof of receipt must be provided at the gate on the day of the event (electronic copies will NOT be accepted).

- Parking spots are for vehicles only. Drive aisles must remain clear at all times. No items (coolers, tents, tables, chairs, etc.) of any kind may be placed on the ground behind, in front of, or around parked vehicles. Motorcycles require their own parking spaces. Each motorcycle is required to pay for an individual space. RVs, buses, trailers, and oversized vehicles (any vehicle longer than 19 feet) are prohibited.

- Accessible parking spaces are available in each lot by reservation only. You must have a state-issued person with disabilities plate or placard to park in an accessible parking space. Those who purchase accessible parking spaces and do not have valid plates / tags will be turned away at the gate.

- Pets are not permitted at the Kerrville Sports Complex. Exceptions will be made for service animals.

- Overnight dry camping is not permitted at this location.

- Glass containers, consumption of alcohol and smoking (including e-cigarettes) are not permitted on complex grounds.
