Judah & the Lion to headline the Kerrville Eclipse Festival

Kerrville, Texas (Feb. 28, 2024) – In just a few short weeks, the City of Kerrville is set to experience a once-in-a-lifetime view of the total solar eclipse that will stretch across North America on Monday, April 8, 2024. The City of Kerrville Parks and Recreation Department is thrilled to announce alternative folk band Judah & the Lion will be headlining the highly anticipated Kerrville Eclipse Festival.

In anticipation of the headliner's new album "The Process", coming out on May 10, attendees can enjoy hearing some of their top songs such as "Suit and Jacket" and "Take It All Back". The band is recognized for their energetic live performances and is sure to capture and engage their audience, adding to the eclipse experience.

"From the awe of witnessing the totality of the solar eclipse to the joy of jamming out with Judah & the Lion, we're thrilled to create an unforgettable, family-friendly event where moments of wonder will create memories that last a lifetime," said Recreation Manager Rosa Ledesma.

As a NASA-designated viewing location, the city's position within the path of totality is expected to attract traveling astronomy enthusiasts. NASA will be on-site at Louise Hays Park for the Kerrville Eclipse Festival, where they will be nationally broadcasting the phenomenon as it occurs.

The free and open-to-the-public celebration will be held from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. where event goers can expect a full day of family-friendly activities including yoga classes, food vendors, astronomy keynote speakers, and a headlining performance by Judah & The Lion.

The festival has coined the phrase "See the Eclipse, Stay for the Totality of our Event" to spread awareness about the ask for guests to do their part in minimizing traffic congestion by staying for the full line-up of activities. Attendees are encouraged to bring chairs and blankets for the day and to opt for cash as electronic transactions may be unavailable. The Kerrville Eclipse Festival and the City of Kerrville are asking guests to carpool, bring bikes, or skates to remain at their viewing locations after totality, as traffic is expected to be heavier than normal. Using the Kerrville River Trail as a means for getting to the event is highly encouraged. Commemorative Kerrville Eclipse shirts, posters, stickers, and postcards will be available for purchase, protective eyewear will also be for purchase onsite, while supplies last.
