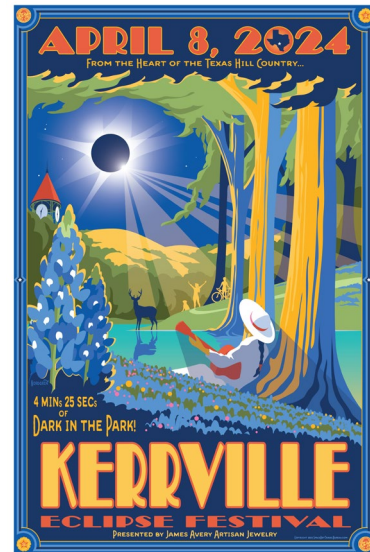
Kerrville Eclipse Festival event schedule presented by James Avery
