### **About Kerrville-Schreiner Park**

Tucked away on the Guadalupe River, Kerrville-Schreiner Park is 517 acres of Hill Country wilderness, just three miles from charming and historic Downtown Kerrville. The park offers overnight camping and cabin rentals, more than 13 miles of hiking and mountain biking trails, and a spacious, shady riverfront perfect for picnicking and paddling.

Kerrville-Schreiner Park was built by the historic Civilian Conservation Corps in the 1930s and was a state park until 2004, when the City of Kerrville adopted it as a city park. As one of the best mountain biking destinations in the Hill Country, this location is highly sought after by adventure seekers, RVers, and outdoor enthusiasts alike.
