

**CITY OF KERRVILLE, TEXAS
RESOLUTION NO. 04-2025**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO
THE KERRVILLE RIVER TRAIL MASTER PLAN**

WHEREAS, the City owns and maintains a number of parks and recreational areas that are intended to be used by and to benefit the public; and

WHEREAS, in September 2008, City Council adopted Resolution 74-2008, which adopted the *Kerrville Parks, Recreation, and Open Spaces Master Plan*, which included the *Kerrville River Trail Master Plan*; and

WHEREAS, in 2011, City Council approved funding for the construction of a six mile river trail to be created and maintained by the city as part of the City's parks; and

WHEREAS, in 2019 City Council adopted Resolution 27-019, which adopted an updated *Kerrville River Trail Master Plan*; and

WHEREAS, in September 2022, City Council adopted Resolution 56-2022 approving the *Singing Wind Park Master Plan*, which included extensions of the Kerrville River Trail; and

WHEREAS, the Kerrville River Trail currently consists of approximately six miles of concrete trail; and

WHEREAS, City staff recently updated the Kerrville River Trail Master Plan by amending it to remove the proposed section of the river trail from the Riverside Nature Center to Granger MacDonald Park and adding several extensions; and

WHEREAS, on December 12, 2024, the City's Parks and Recreation Advisory Board reviewed and approved the update to the Kerrville River Trail Master Plan and recommended its adoption by City Council; and


WHEREAS, the City Council finds it to be in the public interest to adopt the *Kerrville River Trail Master Plan*, as amended;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KERRVILLE, KERR COUNTY, TEXAS:

SECTION ONE. City Council adopts the document titled the *Kerrville River Trail Master Plan*, which is attached as **Exhibit A**, and amends the existing plan.

SECTION TWO. City Council hereby repeals Resolution No. 27-2019.

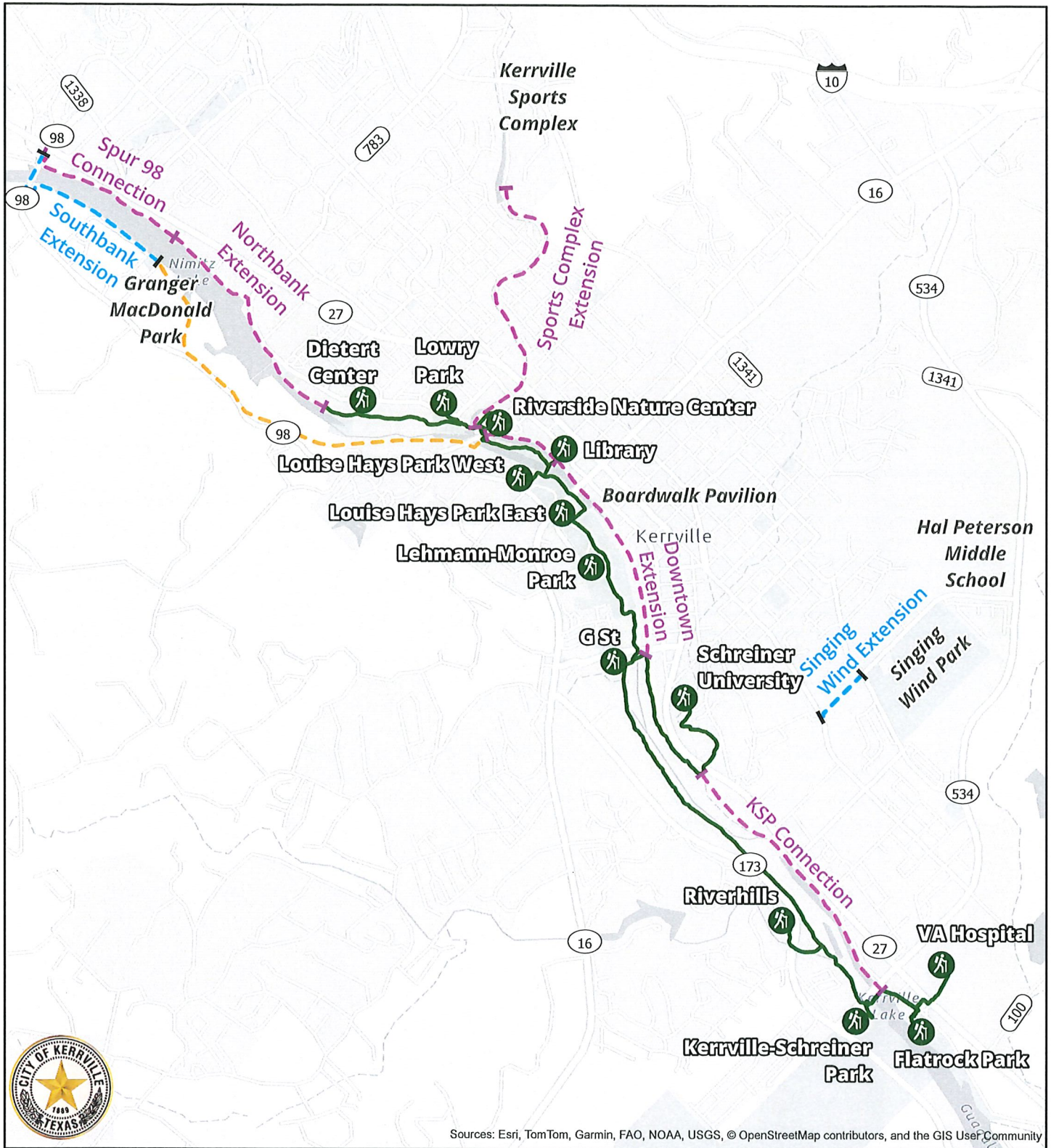

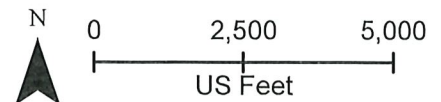
