Construction to begin April 22 on Webster Avenue sidewalk

Kerrville (April 9, 2021) – The City of Kerrville has hired Mick Freed Concrete to construct a new sidewalk along Webster Avenue from West Barnett Street to Carver Park in the historic Doyle Area neighborhood. Construction crews plan to begin work April 22 and anticipate the project will take approximately two to three weeks. Work will begin at Carver Park, and traffic controls will be set as needed for the duration of the construction along Webster Avenue.

The new sidewalk was a neighborhood-requested action item during the development of the Doyle Area Plan, which included a Guiding Principle calling for “develop(ing) sidewalks and trails along key corridors within the Doyle Community.” The construction is also in line with the community/neighborhood character/placemaking element of the Kerrville 2050 Plan, which “focuses on principles and strategies that can be used to ensure that future development and land uses strengthen the character of neighborhoods and enhance the sense of community within Kerrville.”

Please adhere to all construction traffic signs throughout this process to establish a safe working environment for the contractor.
