- Recycling for customers with Monday & Tuesday garbage collection days
- Holiday - No Service
- Holiday - Makeup Service Day
- Recycling for customers with Wednesday & Thursday garbage collection days
- Bulk Waste Drop off Month
- Brush/Yard Waste Collections – Occurs every month (see schedule below)
- Bulk Waste Collections – Occurs in April and October during the same weeks as brush (see schedule below)

Curbside collection for Household Trash and Recycle Materials begins at 7:30 a.m. on the day of service assigned to your street. **All carts must be placed out prior to 7:30 a.m.** Carts may be placed at the curb after 8:00 p.m. the night prior to collections, but must be removed by 10:00 p.m. on the collection day. Place carts with lid opening facing the street. The combined weight of the contents and the cart shall not exceed 100 lbs. **Do not place Household Trash or Yard Waste in Recycle Cart; mixing will cause a disruption in service.** Please see Makeup Service Days Section below for Holiday weeks. If there is an unforeseeable delay, collections will resume the next working day. Please do not store carts at or near the curb on non-collection days. For arrangements to pick up items/debris not accepted as part of curbside collections, please contact Republic Services for rates and requirements.

Household Trash- curbside collection is **once a week** on the day designated to your street and consists of solid waste derived from household residential units. Household trash **does not include yard waste, hazardous waste, or construction debris** (i.e. sink, vanity, tub, toilet, cabinet, cement, bricks, shingles, etc.).

- **Household trash cart (dark blue lid) requirements and tips:** Only issued carts designated for regular garbage shall be used for household trash. To help keep your cart clean and minimize litter, it is highly recommended that you place all trash into a bag prior to placing it in the cart. Additional carts can be requested by calling Republic Services or the City of Kerrville (fees apply). Lids must be shut completely for service.

Recycling- curbside collection is **every other week** on your designated Friday. Recyclables consists of paper products (newspaper, magazines, direct mail, cardboard boxes, and shredded paper in paper bags), number 1, 2, or 5 plastic containers (look for the recycling triangle), rinsed unbroken glass jars and bottles, rinsed aluminum or tin cans. **Do not place items in plastic bags.** Plastic bags can be recycled at your local grocery store.

- **Recycling cart (light blue lid) requirements and tips:** Only the issued carts designated for recycling shall be used for recycling. **Do not place items in plastic bags inside or outside the cart, as they will not be collected. If needed, excess recyclables can be dropped off at the Recycling Drop off site located at 3315 Loop 534.** To help keep your cart clean and to prevent contamination, please rinse any recyclables that previously contained food or beverages. Contamination may cause the entire load in the collection vehicle to be landfilled rather than recycled. **New Year’s, Thanksgiving and Christmas weeks – collections occur on Saturday.**

Brush/Yard Waste Service –curbside collection is **once a month** and occurs on your **designated week**, which is based on your garbage collection day. **If services are delayed, they will continue through the following week.** Items must be placed out for collection on Monday of your week no later than 7:30 a.m. Yard Waste consists of bagged leaves or grass clippings (25-bag limit – 35-pound limit per bag). Yard Waste also consists of cut brush and limbs; stumps, roots or shrubs with no dirt; all limited to 6-inch diameter, 6-foot length, and a 2-cubic yard limit. Stack neatly with cut ends facing curb. The 2-cubic yard limit (can be determined by multiplying in feet - the length x width x height / 27) will be strictly adhered to with excess volume documented. Do not place yard waste in issued carts. Small containers may be used but must not weigh more than 45 pounds when filled with contents. All yard waste must be at least 3ft. from other objects. Yard waste shall not be placed out for more than 10 days as to where a nuisance is created. Such nuisance may be subject to code compliance enforcement. **It is recommended yard waste be placed out on Sunday prior to your collection week. Be advised, service crew will only pass down the street once and document it as being cleared once this occurs.**

Monthly Brush/Yard Waste Collection Schedule – Based on Your Garbage Day

Monday Collection – Have items out by 7:30 a.m. on Monday of this color-coded week

Tuesday Collection – Have items out by 7:30 a.m. on Monday of this color-coded week

Wednesday/Thursday Collection – Have items out by 7:30 a.m. on Monday of this color-coded week

Bulk Waste Drop Off – (Kerrville Residents) Owners or renters of residential units are eligible for a free voucher, which may be used to dispose of items at the Transfer Station – 3315 Loop 534 (Veterans Highway). Eligible residents must have an active utility account that includes Solid Waste services. Vouchers obtained during the quarter designated for drop off (**see calendar**) must be used within that quarter. This opportunity is provided twice/year. Vouchers may be obtained at City Hall – 701 Main Street, Kerrville (Water Records Office). Items that can be disposed of are the same as those that may be placed for bulk waste collection – No Construction Debris. Please contact Republic Services for list of prohibited items not allowed at the Landfill/Transfer Station.

Bulk Waste Collection – Curbside collections for the quarter are for bulky items (not household trash) only and not small items that typically fit into your cart. Items include appliances such as washers, dryers, stoves, indoor/outdoor furniture, and water heaters. Carpet will be collected if it is cut into sections that measure no more than 6ft. by 6ft. and is individually rolled and tied. Refrigerators, freezers, and A/C window units will be collected only if the refrigerant has been reclaimed and tagged by a licensed technician. No construction debris or prohibited items listed below are allowed. Collections occur in April and October. Refer to the **schedule** below for dates.

➤ **Prohibited Items:** boxed or bagged items, tires, paint, chemicals, ammunition, yard waste, fencing, household trash, and any construction debris (sheetrock, sink, vanity, tub, pallets, toilets, glass, cabinet, paneling, cement, bricks, lumber, shingles or any other materials from remodeling). To avoid City Ordinance code enforcement action, do not place items on curbside more than 10 days prior to your collection day. Please do not place items on top of water meters and ensure items are clear of any power lines, vehicles, water/gas lines, and mailboxes. **If you have questions, please call the City of Kerrville or Republic Services prior to placing items out.**

Bulk Waste Collection Schedules for April and October: based on your regular garbage day.

Monday Collection must have items out by 7:30 a.m. on Monday, April 1, 2019; Monday, October 7, 2019

Tuesday Collection must have items out by 7:30 a.m. on Monday, April 8, 2019; Monday, October 14, 2019

Wednesday/Thursday Collection must have items out by 7:30 a.m. on Monday, April 15, 2019; October 21, 2019

Makeup Service Days - All collection days will shift over to the next service day following a Holiday. This applies to all curbside collection for regular trash and recycling during Holidays listed below:

New Year's Day: Tuesday, January 1, 2019 – NO SERVICE

Monday, New Year's Eve will be a regular service day. Delayed collections resume on Wednesday, with recycling scheduled for Saturday, January 5, 2019.

Thanksgiving Day: Thursday, November 28, 2019 – NO SERVICE

Thursday's garbage services occur on Friday, November 29, 2019.

Friday's recycling services occur on Saturday, November 30, 2019.

Christmas Day: Wednesday, December 25, 2019 – NO SERVICE

Tuesday, Christmas Eve will be a regular service day. Delayed collections resume on Thursday, with recycling scheduled for Saturday, December 28, 2019.

Landfill, Transfer Station & Recycling Drop off Site

These locations are at 3315 Loop 534 (Veterans Highway). Open to the public: Monday through Friday, 7:30 a.m. to 4:50 p.m. (incoming traffic) to allow closure by 5:00 p.m. and Saturday, 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. (incoming traffic). Citizens may drop off accepted recyclables into convenient recycling dumpsters and designated locations for metals. There are no fees for the Recycling Drop off site, but certain rules and requirements apply. Please call Republic Services or the City of Kerrville for further information.
