Librarians will provide instructions as well as supplies.

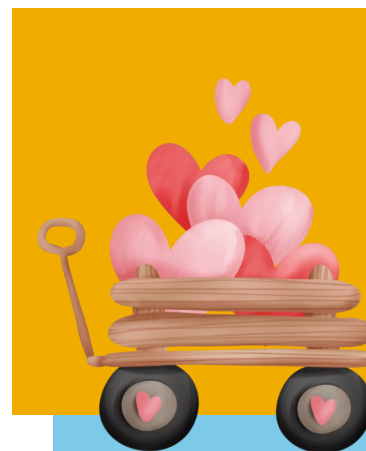
This craft will be held on Feb. 3rd from 2 p.m.— 3 p.m. in the first-floor meeting room.
