

2026 RESIDENTIAL SOLID WASTE CALENDAR

For information on **2 free trips to the landfill**, see the Bulky Item Drop Off section on back for details.

Household trash is collected once a week on the day designated to your street and consists of solid waste derived from household residential units.

Cart Placement Requirements

- Must be placed curbside by 7:30 a.m. with lid opening facing street.
- May be placed curbside after 8:00 p.m. the night prior to collection, but must be removed by 10:00 p.m. on collection day.
- Lids must be completely closed for service.
- Carts must be at least 3 feet from other objects.

Curbside collection of Recycling is every other week on your designated Friday. Do not place items in plastic bags or outside of cart – they won't be collected. Plastic bags may be recycled at your local grocery store.

TRASH

(Blue or black lid)

Does not include:

- Hazardous waste
- Construction debris (sink, vanity, tub, toilet, cabinet, cement, bricks, shingles, etc.)

Only issued carts designated for regular garbage shall be used for household trash.

Placing trash into trash bags before putting in the cart is recommended.

- Carts with household trash or Yard Waste in the Recycle Cart will not be serviced.
- Do not store carts at or near the curb on non-collection days.

RECYCLE (light blue lid)

includes:

- Paper Products *
- Plastic Containers:
No. 1, 2, or 5
*(Look for the
recycle triangle)*
- Rinsed aluminum
or tin cans
- Rinsed, unbroken
glass bottles/jars

Only carts designated for recycling shall be used for recycling.

Newspaper, shredded paper in paper bags, magazines, direct mail, and cardboard boxes.

YARD WASTE SERVICE

To help keep your recycling cart clean and prevent contamination, rinse any recyclables previously containing food or beverages. Contamination may cause the entire truckload to be landfilled rather than recycled.

Yard Waste Requirements

- Place brush/yard waste curbside by 7:30 a.m. on Monday of your collection week and at least 3 feet away from other objects.
- Small containers may be used but must not weigh more than 45 pounds when filled.
- Yard waste must not be left curbside more than 10 days. Waste left more than 10 days may be subject to code compliance enforcement.
- Bagged yard waste limits (grass or leaves):
 - No more than 25 bags (no more than 35 pounds per bag)
- Loose yard waste (limbs, shrubs, brush, roots, stumps, etc.) must be
 - No thicker than 6 inches in diameter & no longer than 6 feet
 - Placed curbside with cut end toward street
 - No more than 2 cubic yards, or what will fit in a small pick up bed.
Formula is (in feet) the length x width x height / 27. (Excess will not be picked up.)

YARD WASTE SCHEDULE

(Based on Garbage Day)

Monday	Blue Weeks
Tuesday	Peach Weeks
Wednesday/ Thursday	Purple Weeks

BULKY ITEM COLLECTION

Each March and October, the City sponsors curbside bulky item collection for City residents who have a utility account with trash service. This collection is **not for household trash**, but for bulky items such as washers, dryers, stoves, indoor/outdoor furniture, and water heaters. To avoid City Ordinance code enforcement action, **do not place items curbside more than 10 days prior to your collection week.**

BULKY ITEM DATES

If your garbage day is:	Your bulky item collection date range is:
Monday	March 2-5, 2026 & October 5-8, 2026
Tuesday	March 9-12, 2026 & October 12-15, 2026
Wednesday/ Thursday	March 16-19, 2026 & October 19-22, 2026

Set items out by 7:30 a.m. Monday morning for your designated week.

Acceptable Items:

- Appliances, TVs, Mattresses & Box springs, Refrigerators, freezers and A/C window units will be collected only if refrigerant has been reclaimed & appliance tagged by a licensed technician.
- Carpet cut into 6 ft. x 6 ft. and individually rolled & tied

Prohibited Items:

- Household trash & cardboard
- Small items that fit in the trash bin
- Boxed or bagged items
- Tires
- Oil, Paint & Chemicals
- Ammunition
- Yard Waste
- Construction Debris (sheetrock, sink, vanity, tub, pallets, toilets, glass, cabinet, paneling, cement, bricks, lumber, shingles, or any other materials from remodeling)

BULKY ITEM DROP OFF

The City of Kerrville sponsors two free trips per calendar year to the landfill for certain customers.

Who is eligible for this service?

Owners or renters of residential units who have a City utility account with trash service.

When is this service available?

Vouchers become available Jan. 1st of each year and must be used by Dec. 31st of the same year.

How do I get a voucher?

Drop by City Hall at 701 Main St. or call Public Works at 830-258-1221.

What can I take to the landfill?

Acceptable items are household trash, appliances, furniture, cardboard, and yard debris – No construction debris.

Where is the landfill?

HOURS OF OPERATION


